MINUTES OF THE MEETING

Date:19.12.2020 Time: 2.00PM

The meeting was chaired by the Principal at Internal Quality Assurance Cell.

Chairman-IQAC, welcomed the members of the IQAC Committee. Co-ordinator, IQAC, presided over the meeting. He briefed the Goals, Objectives, Strategy, Functions, Benefits, Follow-ups, roles and responsibilities of members of the institution. He invited the members to share their views.

The items in the agenda were taken for discussion one by one.

- 1. Action taken report of the academic year 2019-20 was reviewed, had the discussion among the members and approved.
- 2. HODs were requested to plan the academic activities and adhere to university guidelines for the implementation. Also instructed to conduct Certificate / Diploma/ add on programmes based on the requirement of the concerned departments to fulfill the demands of the engineering industry and maintain the reports on Feed back collected.
- 3. To enhance the skills among the students, HoDs were requested to conduct Student centric programs. The faculty were advised to play vital role to organize the same. All the faculty were instructed to do the student monitoring / counseling regularly, as the students were attending the class works physically after the COVID period. Educate the faculty to counsel the students periodically to avert any kind of pessimistic attitude among them. The Internal evaluation should be done according to university norms, if university has changed the norms because of COVID.

- 4. The discussion on Research & Innovation, concluded to concentrate on Research Projects and Consultancy, funded by Governmental Sources and Non-Governmental Sources. The HoDs are requested to arrange programs on IPR Activities, Innovation Centre Activities. The faculty should be motivated to publish research articles in reputated journals. The student extension activities like NSS will give the social responsibility to the students towards human values and ethics.
- 5. The Library department was instructed to assist the students in using the E-library / Journals / NPTEL material etc. Maintenance of campus clean & green, WiFi etc.. will take the institute to the next level of environment.
- 6. Resolved to provide more internships / training opportunities through which the students can transform their theoretical knowledge into a practical solution. Training and Placement section has to offer awareness on placement requirements and the measures to be taken to reap success when they appear for campus interviews. They were also advised to plan well in advance and identify the right resource persons in diverse fields to invite for the orientation programme for aspirants towards placement training and higher education.
- 7. It was discussed to motivate the faculty members, to participate/ involve in Grant fetching activities. Also HoDs were take extra effort to create awareness to the faculty on fetching the Research Grants from various funding agencies, so as to enrich the quality and strength of the departments.
- 8. It was resolved to identify the best practices to be followed by the various committees to strengthen.

Co-ordinator –IQAC, solicited the continued support of the members for sharing their rich knowledge and wide experience for furthering the mission of the IQAC.

Chairman, IQAC, proposed the vote of thanks to all the members of the IQAC Committee and expressed gratitude for their sustained involvement and for making the meeting a grand success.
