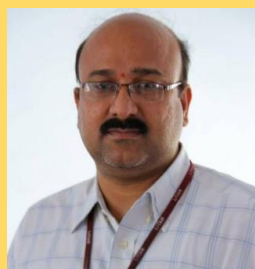
□ Principal's Message:

WEBSITE LAUNCH

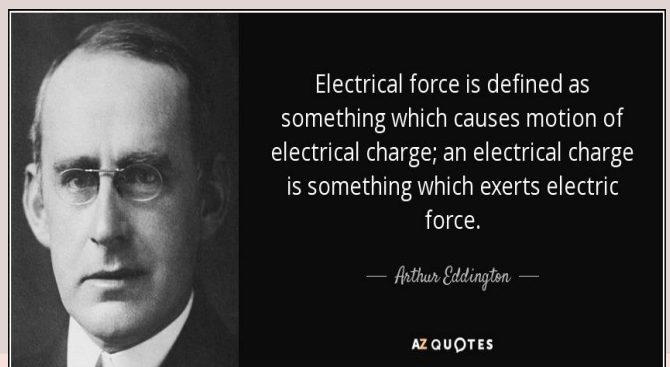
